FORM OF GOVERNMENT: Aldermanic-City Form. Six Aldermen are elected from three wards, with four-year terms staggered so that half are elected every two years. The Mayor serves as Chief Executive Officer and is elected at-large every four years, as is the City Clerk and City Treasurer.

SUMMARY OF PURPOSE: It is the purpose of the City of Lexington to promote and protect the health, safety, and welfare or legal rights of the general public, while effecting changes to encourage the progress and development of the socioeconomic structure within the City.
